Hence, listening to the Panchangam at the beginning of a New Year brings great strength to perform daily karma in addition to bringing good luck. Listening to Panchangam keeps mind clear and gives good vibes, eliminates enemies and effects of bad dreams, gives the result of taking a bath in holy Ganges and donating a cow, increases life span, and brings good fortune.
